Public Nuisance

Extension Of Electric Plant Has Residents Of Public Up In Arms



“less than 50 meters from the closest houses,” as well as the fact that two new motors would be installed at

the electric plant “without proper treatment of the smoke.” In response to a letter written to Bruno Magras, the president of the island council responded by explaining the energy issues on the island, with a level of production that no longer meets its needs, and the necessity of using land close to the electric plant to install the generators, which will be dismantled once the new motors are built and put into service.

a maximum of 70 decibels during the day at the edge of the property, then according to the ASP, the noise from even one generator was already over the limit.

So how is it possible that the territorial council held a special meeting on December 30, 2010 during which they modified the local environmental code to allow 75 decibels during the day at the edge of the property, that even the new level was largely exceeded as soon as two generators were in action, and often until 10 o'clock at night!

The reading taken on January 30 by Colbert Brin of ASP with an electronic sound-level meter indicated 92 decibels at the edge of the property and 81 decibels at the closest houses when the five generators are working.

The sound pollution is not the only thing that concerns the residents. There is also the problem of smoke from the electric plant. At the meeting on December 30, the territorial council also voted to amend the environmental code to allow new installations, as well as the old motors, to go far beyond the national regulations, with the excuse that if the national rules had to be respected, it would cause a greater use of distilled water, and in consequence, increased electricity. “Better for us to breath polluted air,” says the ASP ironically. And the association has no intention of giving up their fight.

Noise Pollution

Status quo until December 24, 2010 when the generators were first turned on, signifying the beginning of noise pollution for the local residents: “An incessant droning and vibration invaded the neighborhood. In early January we decided to do sound level tests over the course of several days, based on the number of generators working at the same time,” explains David Brin, president of ASP. They may have been unofficial but these tests were educational. If one considers that the national noise pollution ceiling is fixed at



Kite Surfing

Bruno Sroka Sets Saint Barth-Saint Martin Record

Triple world champion and the first kite surfer to navigate around Cape Horn (2008), Bruno Sroka recently visited St Barth, after making two kite-surfing crossings from Saint Barth to Saint Martin within two weeks. And each time, a record to set!

again: On Thursday, February 3, Bruno and Enguerrand set out on a second crossing from Saint Barth to Saint Martin. According to Enguerrand, "Conditions were excellent that day with winds from the East-North-east between 15 and 20 knots and waves averaging six feet.



57 Minutes The First Time

On January 27, during Bruno Sroka's first visit to Saint Barth, he decided to make his first Saint Barth-Saint Martin crossing, with Enguerrand, the kite surf instructor from "7ème ciel de Saint-Barth." They left from the lagoon in Grand Cul de Sac and arrived in Orient Bay, a distance of 30km (18 miles). Weather conditions were exceptional, with 20 knots of wind and eight-foot waves. Alan Jaouen, from R de Saint-Barth, provided security aboard a boat. For this first attempt, Bruno covered the distance in 57 minutes while Enguerrand took 1h17mn. The goal of the two kite surfers was to create a record to beat... a challenge for anyone who wanted to try.

The Second Crossing In 50 Minutes, 10 Seconds

The conditions were more difficult than during the first crossing however, but our goal was to beat our own records."

This time, Saint-Barth Sailor's Concept 36, with Foulques as skipper, was the security boat and brought the kite surfers back after the race. "The first 20 minutes of the crossing were calm, but after we passed Forchue it was terrible. We had to stay on the same tack for the rest of the crossing and it was very tiring," admits Enguerrand, who bettered his own time by almost 20 minutes (58minutes, 30 seconds), while Bruno set a new record of 50 minutes, 10 seconds.

Bruno Sroka has left the island, but Enguerrand is thinking about making another crossing in the next few weeks with another kite surfer... when the weather conditions are favorable.

The Power of Social Media

A funny thing happened on the way to the forum, the www.sbhonline.com forum that is: A widely diverse bunch of people who visit Saint Barth have become a "forum family," a gaggle of friends, a support group, and a social network that makes a financial impact on the island. Hosted on a website originally created by Kara and Bob Brooks, and now owned by WIMCO, this forum may be one of a kind: people have made incredibly close friendships, attend "family" funerals, provide bridges over troubled waters, and of course have a lot of fun together.

The forum has three volunteer moderators: Dennis Cooney, John King, and Tim Thornton (who owns a home in Vitet and spends the most time on the island of the three). "SBHonline was purchased several years ago by WIMCO. At that time John King and I had already begun moderating," explains Thornton. "We were apprehensive about the new ownership, but WIMCO has had a totally "hands off" policy when it comes to the site's forums. Discussion of St. Barth's rental agencies, like all other topics on the site, is open,

frank, and honest. John, Dennis, and I as unpaid volunteers have been given total authority to guide the forums in this unique relationship with WIMCO."

"Tim and John asked me to get involved when they realized they needed a "bad cop" to their "good cop," adds Cooney. "We can be a rowdy bunch, like

THE ABSTRACT FORMS OF DAVE STEVENSON



Sculptor and jeweler, New York-based artist Dave Stevenson (www.artinjection.com) is a master of abstract forms, from his large bronzes to sterling silver shapes that adorn the neck and wrist. Back in Saint Barth for his 10th anniversary exhibit at Les Artisans in Gustavia as of this week, Stevenson has two new pieces with strong visual impact.

“My two new sculptures are kindred spirits,” says Stevenson, who relates how he was working on a large piece that didn’t seem right so he snapped it in half for two smaller ones. “I completed them both last

spring over the course of several months,” he adds. When casting his bronzes, Stevenson uses Foundry Polich Tallix in Rock Tavern, NY, where celebrated artists Jeff Koons and Jasper Johns also work.


The first of the new sculptures is called Pegasus, which Stevenson feels has an equine feel about it, but as he admits: “The names come after the creation of the pieces... the creation itself is abstract.” The second new piece is different in that it is finished in bright glossy yellow paint. “It is a prototype called Crustacea because it has a shellfish feel but also has a

birdlike feel, with curves as if the are soaring in flight,” says Stevenson, who notes that the final version will be cast in limited-edition bronze or bright yellow aluminum: “I’m waiting to get feedback. My first piece in this series of sculptures 20 years ago was yellow as well, it just seemed to fit this time... it’s a demanding color that attracts your attention.”

likes to take one design and morph it into something new.

Stevenson recently made a pair of cufflinks that remind the artist of a motorcycle: “These were also a commission, and struggled for months to come up with a design and incorporate red and black stone, garnets and onyx. I don’t use stones a lot, only when people ask,” he notes. “These morphed into

Crustacea had a rough trip to the island: “After four days packing it with spray insulation foam got a hair-line crack in shipping,” Steveson explains. “To fix it, I went to the local hardware store and got resin for four euros, then took it Garage Michel, a car body shop in St Jean Carénage who was nice enough to let me use his spray painting booth to repaint the sculpture and use glazing powder, a specialty product now for sale on the island, to fill in minute tin holes in the surface. I couldn’t have done it without him.”



a piece called Hornet I am showing here as well.”

A little something that is very appealing (and affordable) is a little silver drop: “I got out of bed at 4am and made this little critter than Jo-Anne at Les Artisans called Dune Bug,” says Stevenson. “She helps me realize my rough concepts.”

The new jewelry in Stevenson’s collection includes Stag, a modular design based on a sterling silver pendant that was a commission for a bride. “I used the mold to create Stag later,” says Stevenson, who
