# FEMUR DONATES A CARDIAC STRESS TEST MACHINE TO DE BRUYN HOSPITAL

St Barth's De Bruyn Hospital is now equipped with a new ergometer for echocardiography stress

the patient pedal to

health, was
financed by
FEMUR (Foundation for Emergency Medical
Equipment) and its
American equivalent, the St

Barthélemy Medical Equipment Foundation (SBMEF). This new donation by FEMUR is in response to a request made by the local hospital, where FEMUR has previously donated such essential equipment as an ultrasound machine and a CT Scan. The founding president of FEMUR, Peter R. Mund, wished to "equip De Bruyn Hospital of Saint Barthélemy with all that is required," recalls Raymond Magras, treasurer of the foundation. "So that our visitors, in case of health issues while on the island, can be correctly diagnosed before being evacuated elsewhere," Magras adds.

# EMMANUEL RENAUT: TASTE OF SAINT-BARTH'S HONORARY PATRON



The honorary patron of the second annual Taste Saint-Barth Gourmet Festival has been announced: Emmanuel Renaut, who has been awarded three Michelin stars for his restaurant, Flocons de Sel, in Megève, and who also been

crowned with the Meilleur Ouvrier de France title. The Territorial Tourism Committee (CTTSB). which organizes this gourmet festival, made the announcement on Monday, July 6. This second edition of the Taste of Saint-Barth will take place November 5-8, 2015 and once again reveal the culinary pleasures that await visitors to the island. The way it works is that talented chefs are invited to work in the kitchens of the partnering restaurants, where they create special gourmet menus. This year, the accent is on French cuisine, with the following chefs on the roster: Christophe Aribert, Jérôme Nutile, David Toutain, Alexandre Mazzia, and Stéphanie Le Quellec. They will all work under the aegis of Emmanuel Renaut, who follows in the footsteps of Jean-Georges Vongerichten, honorary patron of the festival last year.

### EDMOND GRÉAUX PRESENTS A GIFT TO THE COLLECTIVITY



On July 14, for Bastille Day, Edmond Gréaux presented the Collectivity with a red, white, and blue French flag, that he created himself. President Bruno Magras and Raymond Magras, noted the talents of this native of Saint Barth, son of a fisherman, who spent his life aboard boats. As they pointed out, Gréaux learned his craft aboard the schooner, Père Labat, before migrating to St Thomas. He then returned to Saint Barth as crew chief on David Rockefeller's yacht, Wayfarer. This was the first step toward a long career on motor yachts in the United States. Based in Florida for many years, Gréaux has returned to his native island. "Someone who has spent 65 years of his life working, can not just sit there with nothing to do," joked Raymond Magras, as he presented the flag woven by Gréaux, who still likes to work with his hands. Not to mention that he made the flag in just one week.






































### JAPANESE ART AT FERGUS McCAFFREY GALLERY:

### NATSUYUKI NAKANISHI AND JIRO TAKAMATSU

atsuyuki Nakanishi and Jiro Takamatsu formed the legendary collective Hi Red Center in 1963 along with Genpei Akasegawa; named from the English translations of the first characters of their surnames— "taka" (high), "aka" (red) and "naka" (center). The movement was shortlived, but produced performance pieces involving the community and participants in Tokyo, which sought to eliminate the boundary between art and life. After the movement ended in 1964, Nakanishi and Takamatsu worked individually in order to pursue their own artistic practice.

In his over 50-year career, Nakanishi has constantly challenged the role of the artist and his relation to art making. Describing his art as coming to its own fruition, Nakanishi works to deconstruct formal elements to recompose them into abstract forms. The drawings featured in the exhibition each have their own individual development, yet are

explorations of a continuous idea. Though minimal in nature, Nakanishi's works hold much depth and investigate the abstract process that gravity imposes on the medium on a flat plane.

Perhaps one of the most influential artists working in Japan during the 1960s and 1970s, Jiro Takamatsu altered the evolution of conceptual art in Japan as an artist and theorist, dominating Japanese artistic discourse during those years. The exhibition features a selection

of drawings that provide insights into Takamatsu's process as an artist to develop abstract ideas through 2D work. His series. In the Form of a Square, Takamatsu uses pencil and gouache to create strategic waves and straight lines, exposing the paper below. This minimally approached series of works on paper explores optical illusions and manipulation of form; a concept he had continually explored through various media during his artistic career.

# CONCERN ABOUT "AUTOUR DU ROCHER" HOTEL PROJECT


group of island residents decided to organize a meeting regarding the proposed project to expand and reopen a hotel at "Autour du Rocher." We have serious concerns about this project, and more generally about the future of the island. In particular, the need to increase the number of hotel rooms, which will require housing for the staff and their families. After the new hotel project in Flamands, and one in Lurin, is there now to be one at Autour du Rocher? Where are we going with all this new construction? How are we going to house everyone, as there are already workers who are housed in deplorable conditions? Some are squashed six into a house

with two bedrooms with an exorbitant rent, others sleep in their cars, or in former cisterns. As for schools, are they able to absorb more children? Not to mention the already crowded traffic conditions, noise pollution, and decreased charm for the beaches... In short, our quality of life will suffer. In addition, how is it possible that an existing green zone can simply be reclassified? For what reason?

This column presents the worries expressed by a responsible and concerned population to its elected officials. Where are we heading? We elected you, and you have a responsibility in terms as far as we are concerned. That is to think

about our future when you make decisions about such projects. How can the members of the executive council validate a project that the members of the urbanism commission largely rejected? Faced with such a consequential decision, we are going to start a citizen's petition to request that the territorial council retract the urbanism certificate accorded to this project, and initiate a moratorium on the construction of new hotels. ## **Get Ready to Rock**

ugust is time for the island to rock with the 7th annual St Barth Summer Sessions, a great livemusic series organized by Saint Barth Rocks and based at La Plage restaurant at Tom Beach Hotel, August 5-15, 2015. The vibe also spreads across the island with concerts at L'Esprit Jean-Claude Dufour. Christopher Hotel, Cheval Blanc Isle de France, Le Carré, and Bonito, plus a fantastic festival finale at La Plage on August 15, the culmination of 11 nights of hip music.

Singer **Sophia Urista** returns this year with the funk group **Concrete Jungle** and her blues-

inspired songs. Residencies at the world-renowned "Sleep No More" at The McKittrick Hotel, Duane Park Restaurant on the Bowery, and The Box inspire her to connect with her audiences in unconventional and refreshing ways. She is also lead singer of NYC rock and roll trio "The VeeVees" with Andrea Belfiore on drums and songwriter Garrett Cillo on guitar and vocals. She performs at La Plage, August 5-9.

Josh Flowers & The Wild is a London-based four-piece band that blends crunching blues with rock and folk influences, all underpinned by engaging, honest songwriting. Led by Josh





Flowers, with Squiff on cello, Dave on bass, and Reuben on drums, they charm their audiences with impressive musicianship, country-inspired harmonies and high-energy shows. Performing at L'Esprit on August 10, and La Plage, August 11-14.

Life On Planets is a softspoken, hard-rocking group from Baltimore, whose music fuses indie art-rock and electronic music in a pairing of two dramatically different personas, merging as one for a serendipitous, romantic sound that's now been signed to the Double Standard label. Life on Planets has also released music through Better on Foot, where the single "Apollo" made waves in early 2014. Performing at La Plage, August 13-15.

Returning singer/songwriter Greta Karen will enchant audiences at the Cheval Blanc hotel on August 11, at Le Carré on August 12, at Bonito on August 13, The Christopher Hotel on August 14, and be part of the finale event at La Plage on August 15.

Adding her cool mixes to the festival is **Vikkinova**, a past favorite at La Plage, who has also performed at Burning Man and at Serafina in the Meatpacking District in NYC. She will be at La Plage on August 8, 13, and 14, The Christopher Hotel on August 9, and back at La Plage to help close things out with style on August 15.

# St Barth Family Festival, July 31-August 17



Js and musical artists from New York City, Las Vegas, The Hamptons, Los Angeles, Miami, Paris, and Ibiza perform in Saint Barth from July 31 thru August 17 during the 2015 edition of the popular St Barth Family Festival. Among them, the highly anticipated DJ, The Avener, internationally known for his hit single "Fade Out Lines."

As of Friday, July 31, the 2015 edition of the St Barth Family Festival is happening. A galaxy of artists from the international scene performing in all four corners of the island. The action starts at Ti St Barth, with the acoustic duo of Miguel Caballer (singer/guitar) and Joël Netry (percussion), who open the festivities with an evening of fiery flamenco/gypsy music.

Throughout the festival, the Ti St Barth "Caribbean tavern" in Pointe Milou, The First,

and Eden Rock (for a special soiree on August 9) host the hip-hop vibe of **Dex**ter Love, a major DJ from Brooklyn, who spins for such international clients as Guess and Samsung, among a long list. DJ Mario Giorno is up next, remembered in St Barth for Cactus Café soirees, and his compilations for mixcloud.com.

Straight from Los Angeles, **Greg Cerrone**, the son of Marc Cerrone (author of the hit "Give Me Love") heats things up at clubs around the world, after a long collaboration with Radio FG. Find him at The First and at Ti St Barth in August.

Tom Costino, resident DJ at Fouquet's and George V in Paris, is also part of the party, as well as William Geslin of the legendary "Save The Robots" club in New York. Also among the stars of this summer sizzle is the international phenomenon, **The Avener**. After a long residence on the Côte d'Azur, the young and talented Tristan Casara popped out of the shadows and into the spotlight with his hit single "Fade Out Lines." A number one hit in at least 17 countries.

Also anticipated, Manu Lanvin and his group, featuring his great rock-blues vocals, for a special soiree at Ti St Barth with his brother Léo Lanvin. Popular at festivals (including Cannes where he is the official

DJ), Léo is one of the artists warmly welcomed to Saint Barth.

The saxophone of Natty Rico will be heard during the festival, along with such DJs as Fabien Koufach and Chris Magic from New York with their house music; plus GetDown, Jérôme Barthélemy, Carole.G, Franck N., and Gregory Baker of their Open Format sets.

At the Yacht Club, fans of Caribbean sounds and hip-hop will be on the dance floor moving to the music of DJs Leila, Moody Mike, Blaze, Bam, Outkast, and Vince.

It's time to get in the groove: the 15 days of the St Barth Family Festival have begun. Through August 17, an exceptional summer rendezvous!
