St Barth Music Festival Jazz with Monty Alexander

ST BARTH MUSIC FESTIVAL: JAZZ WITH MONTY ALEXANDER ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 24

The 32nd annual St. Barth Music Festival concludes on a high note on Sunday, January 24, with a concert featuring the Monty Alexander Jazz Trio at the Catholic Church in Gustavia at 5pm. The trio comprises Monty Alexander, piano, Hassan Shakur, bass, and Chuck Redd, percussion.

Alexander is a jazz giant, whose music encompasses various genres and styles, and his career has spanned five decades.

"I was born and raised in Kingston, Jamaica until the age of 17," says Alexander. "My musical roots are classic jazz but I can never discard the influence of my Jamaican heritage, Mento, Calypso, and Jamaican folk music in general, which is reflected in all I do and play—happily so."

His projects range from having assisting Natalie Cole in her tribute album to her father, Nat "King" Cole, in 1991, and the resulting album, "Unforgettable", won seven Grammy Awards. He performed George Gershwin's "Rhapsody in Blue" under the direction of Bobby McFerrin at the Verbier Festival in Switzerland, and recorded the piano track for the film score of Clint Eastwood's "Bird," a movie about the life of jazz titan Charlie Parker.

About his early influences, Alexander adds: "My inspiration was the immense joy I derived from discovering and playing the piano—it started at the age of three, and the sounds/rhythms of Jamaica, all the music I heard from America, including the masters of

jazz such as Louis Armstrong, who I saw play live in Kingston when I was 12 years old, but also the rhythm and blues music I heard on the New Orleans' radio station that we could pick up in Jamaica, and Duke Ellington, Erroll Garner, and the great popular singers from Bing Crosby to Nat "King" Cole and Frank Sinatra."

As a musician from the Caribbean, Alexander enjoys "the beautiful natural settings of St. Barth, of course. And I enjoy

the appreciative and informed St. Barth's audience, many of whom also connect with the Caribbean and African experience." As for what that audience can expect at Sunday's concert, Alexander has a few surprises up his sleeve but notes that he will "aspire to provide a good time and uplifting experience for all." Tickets are available at the door, but the audience is advised to arrive early to guarantee seats—this concert will be hot.

FRANCES DEBROFF AWARDED FRENCH CULTURAL MEDAL

Founder of the St Barth Music Festival, Frances Debroff was awarded the French cultural medal, Chevalier in the Order of Arts and Letters, for her continued work to promote her love of classical music. Bruno Magras, president of the Collectivité of Saint Barthélemy, presented DeBroff with this prestigious medal on Thursday, January 14, 2016, with many of the musicians in this year's festival attending a brief ceremony and champagne



reception at the Collectivité. The Order of Arts and Letters was established in 1957 to recognize eminent artists and writers, as well as people who have contributed significantly to furthering the arts in France and throughout the world.

PIANO CONCERT BY MARIANNE WYMAN AT ANGLICAN CHURCH, JANUARY 25



Marianne Kilday Wyman will present a piano concert at St. Bartholomew's Anglican Church in Gustavia on Monday January 25, at 6pm. She will be playing pieces by Chopin, Grieg, Mendelssohn, and Mom-pou. The concert will last approximately one hour, and the audience is invited to stay after the concert for light refreshments. Admission is free.

Wyman was born in San Antonio, Texas. She studied music at the University of Texas and later in

New York City. She was musically gifted from an early age. When she was five years old she sang on a weekly children's radio program. Her early years included appearances with the Ed Sullivan touring program, piano recitals in Europe, and starring roles at the International Operschule in Zurich Switzerland. She gave a solo radio recital, which was broadcast throughout Switzerland, and she was first place winner in the Opera Contest at the National Arts Club in New York City.

When she married, she changed her focus from a professional career to raising a family. She con-

tinued to use her musical skills as the piano accompanist to Dorothy Happel, violinist. They presented programs at homes, schools, hospitals, libraries and museums, in New York, New Jersey, and Connecticut.

A resident of Greenwich, Connecticut, Wyman has visited St. Barth several times, and is delighted to present the concert as a gift to the community. She thanks her Greenwich/St. Barth friends, the Days and the Simpsons, and the Anglican Church and its parish administrator Philip Trangmar, for making it possible.

ST. BARTH DENTAL ASSOCIATION : 22ND ANNUAL MEETING



Enjoying the tropical climate while earning continuing education credits, a group of 37 dentists has gathered in Saint Barth, January 18-22, for the 22nd annual conference organized by the St. Barth Dental Association. This year's guest speaker is Michael Moscovitch, DDS, prosthodontist, who is an assistant clinical professor, Division of Restorative Sciences at Boston University, and clinical

instructor, McGill University Residency Program at the Jewish General Hospital in Montreal. His topic is Patient Specific Restorations: The Reality of High Performance Ceramics in the Treatment of Tooth and Implant Supported Cases. The NJ State Board of Dentistry certifies the continuing education credits for this conference. Local dentists are also invited to sit in.

The theme of the confer-

ence is based on recent developments in the esthetic properties of the high performance ceramic material (HPC) Zirconia (3YTZP), which has led to the increased use of this material in place of metal and lesser strength ceramics in dental restorations. Moscovitch's presentation explores the use of high-performance ceramics in tooth and implant-supported crowns and bridges across all case categories.

This conference was founded over 20 years ago, when dentist Ron Goldstein visited St. Barth. He knew the late David Grodberg, an American dentist living in Saint Barth, from his work with the American Dental Association. "David invited him to visit an island dental office. Ron expected a small office with old equipment," noted Harriet Goldberg, in her welcome speech at the 2014 conference. "Instead he walked into a state-of-the-art dental practice with wonderful equipment, CEREC, computer radiography, and Francois Chlous. Ron suggested that if David and Francois created a conference, he and David Garber would speak. And, so the St Barth Dental Association was founded."

Organized by the non-profit association, United Artists of Saint Barth, the exhibit takes place at the Mango restaurant by the beach, where panels will be installed to create the proper décor for the art. 
