The People Have Spoken

Incumbent president of the Collectivité of Saint Barthélemy, Bruno Magras was elected on Sunday, March 19, for another five-year term. This is a man who has been in public service for more than half of his life and has negotiated a lot of tricky waters. His biggest critics claim that he favors increased construction over the environment, so it will be interesting to see how the next five years play out. When the votes were tallied and Magras' list, Saint Barth D'Abord, secured a win in the first round of voting, he confirmed his decision to run again: "The people have spoken..."

But the next generation is starting to make noise and seems to be more environmentally minded. Everyone agrees there is too much of a lot of things—building permits, cars, traffic jams, pollution... so let's see what happens as the new territorial council shapes up after they roll their sleeves up and get to work in April, with 14 seats for Saint Barth D'Abord (two less than

on the current council). Change? Evolution? Status quo?

The island was really hopping during The St Barth Bucket last weekend—and not just at the yacht hop! The Weekly congratulates all the winners, and as our photos attest, these boats are real beauties to watch racing and at the docks. The Port of Gustavia and the Saint Barth Yacht Club did a great job helping the organizers—staff and volunteers—on the water and on shore. It's a tremendous job and things seem to run really smoothly, other than a few of the boats having mechanical problems and one man overboard, who was quickly picked up...

Bravo to The Bucket, and now it's time to hoist our sails and see what's on the horizon for the 8th annual edition of Les Voiles de Saint Barth, heading to our little harbor in mid-April.

Hope to see you aboard The Weekly for our coverage of that challenging nautical event.

SPIIP Wins 2017 St Barth Bucket



Ideal weather conditions with sunny skies and gusty winds marked the 2017 St Barth Bucket as one of the best in recent years. One of the definite highlights was the appearance of six traditional J Class boats, evoking the single-hull races of the America's Cup in days of yore. They sailed in addition to a fleet of 32 yachts,

all over 100' in length, divided into five pursuit classes.

The J Class opened the regatta on Thursday, March 16, when just the six of them were out on the water. After four days of racing, Hanuman—based on the original designs of the 1937 Endeavor II at 136'—was the winner, with a tied point score

with Velsheda, which had victories in three of the around-the-buoy races sailed by that fleet over its first two days.

The big winner this year was the 112' sloop, SPIIP, which won Les Elegantes des Mers class, as well as the perpetual "Bucket Trophy" for best overall performance among all the pursuit classes. The owner

was also awarded a leather-clad bucket from Hermes. Built by Royal Huisman in 2000, the yacht's sophisticated exterior design and engineering are by of German Frers, with interiors by Andrew Winch.

SPIIP'S tactician Tom Whidden revealed that the yacht lost its hydraulics on the last day of The Bucket, Sunday, March 19, provoking a third-place finish, but that was enough to

Whidden. "We went way offshore after the start and came back right on lay line. I'd like to say it was skill, but it was a little bit luck when the wind went left. Then we lost the hydraulics about two-thirds the way up the beat on the backside of the island. We couldn't let the mainsail out and had to trim the jib by hand, heading the boat into the wind to pull in the lines because we didn't have a winch handle."

Les Gazelles des Mers class win went to Visione, a 147' Baltic Yacht built in 2002, with exterior design and engineering by Reichel Pugh Yacht Design, and interiors by R & J Design.

The awards ceremony was held on the evening of March 19 on the main dock in Gustavia, at which time The Bucket Regatta presented a donation of 20,000 euros to the Saint Barth Yacht Club Youth Sailing Program. The 2018 Bucket will take place March 15-18. For additional winners of special prizes and Bucket info and sponsors: bucketregatta.com.

Another Royal Huisman sloop, the 115' Wisp, won Les Mademoiselles del Mers class, while the Perini Navi ketch, Rosehearty at 183', took top honors in Les Grandes Dames des Mers, holding off her closest competitor, Meteor, by taking a course closer to shore than Meteor's on the windward side of the island and tacking to cover her as she began getting closer. On the downwind run to the fin-

ish, Perseus^{^3} blew out her spinnaker, resulting in a third-place finish behind Meteor for the race as well as the series. Rosehearty also won the Perini Navi Trophy for best performance by a Perini Navi yacht in The Bucket.

In the new Corinthian Class for Les Voiles Blanche, the Vitters sloop, the 140' Koo, won after taking over the lead from Q. This is Koo's

fourth Bucket, and the team has been racing non-spinnaker every time, so it's as if this new Corinthian Class was created especially for them.

BRUNO MAGRAS WINS LOCAL ELECTION IN FIRST ROUND



Seemingly unbeatable... After four terms running the island of Saint Barthélemy (two as mayor and two as president of the island council), Bruno Magras once again won the territorial elections in the first round of voting, as held on Sunday, March 19. The list, Saint-Barth d'Abord, led by the incumbent president of the Collectivité, garnered 1950 votes for a total of 53.65%. Bruno Magras will certainly also be elected as president of the Collectivité by the new Territorial Council, which will be installed on Sunday, April 2. Saint-Barth d'Abord will count

14 (out of a total of 19) seats on the council, going to Bruno Magras, Nicole Gréaux, Nils Dufau, Micheline Jacques, Andy Laplace, Marie-Angèle Aubin, Alfred Brin, Juliette Gréaux, Romaric Magras, Séraphine Danet, Corinne Febrissy, Ernest Magras, and Elodie Laplace.

Second place went to the list, Unis Pour Saint-Barthélemy, led by Xavier Lédée, with 747 votes, or 20.55%. This score allows the list to have two people on the council: Franciane Gréaux-Le Quellec along with Xavier Lédée.

Saint-Barth Autrement, the list with Hélène Bernier at the top, received 657 votes. With 18.07%, this list won two seats on the council, which go to Hélène Bernier and Maxime Desouches, a current opposition member on the council.

Tous Pour Saint-Barth, the list led by Bettina Cointre, won but 280 votes, or 7.70%, giving her a seat on the new council. Benoit Chauvin, who gave up his place at the head of this list to Cointre, will no longer serve on the Territorial Council, where he has been an opposition member.

With 3,685 voters, out of 5,478 on the electoral roll, only 67.2% cast a vote. This is a lower percentage than in the last presidential elections, when the 71.5% of the population voted five years ago. There were actually a few more votes than last time, but the overall list comprises more names.

Since the last election, Bruno Magras lost 18 points as compared to 2012, when he won 73.78% of the votes, and obtained 16 seats out of the 19 places on the Territorial Council. 18 points less is a considerable decrease, but with such a huge lead the last time, it would have taken an earthquake to shake things up enough for those who would like to dethrone him.
