# Kay Quattrocchi Retrospective At Territorial Museum

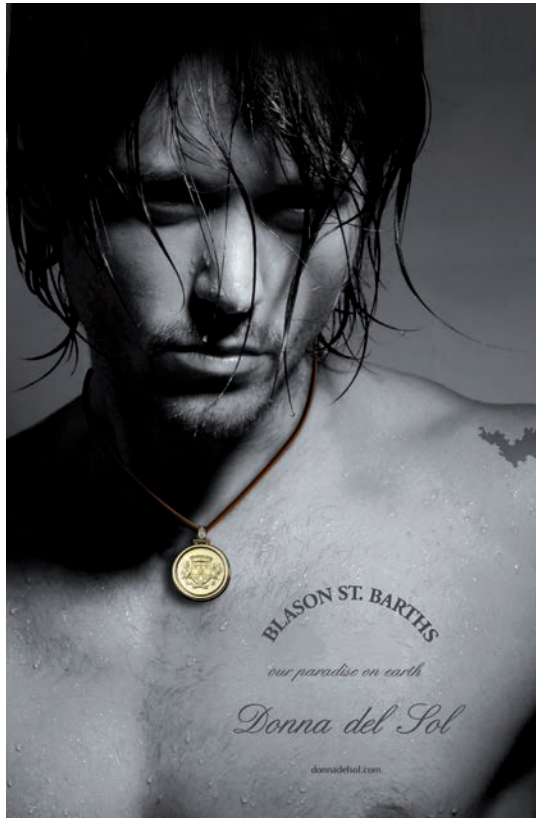


Perhaps without even knowing it, you are likely to have seen the work of Kay Quattrocchi: she designed the large, multi-panel glass sculpture in front of the Collectivité on the dock side, and several of the paintings that adorn the walls of the Hôtel de la Collectivité (Town Hall). The artist will “invade” the Territorial Museum at the Wall House from February 17-23 for retrospective of her work, “Between Art And Science,” based on the themes of time and physics. Alice In Wonderland will make an appearance as well as the famous white rabbit always muttering: “I’m Late, I’m Late, For A Very Important Date.” Two free lectures by Philippe Guillemant, a physicist and researcher from the CNRS (French National Center for Scientific Research), will be held on February 19 and 21 at 7pm at the Capitainerie in Gustavia in conjunction with the exhibit. 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## An Unusual Sailboat In The Harbor



A quick stop in the Port of Gustavia for the magnificent sailboat, Lord Nelson, which made an appearance in Saint Barthélemy last Wednesday and Thursday. Built in 1985, this three-masted square-rigger is one of only two tall ships in the world that is completely accessible for people with handicaps or reduced mobility, as well as those who are able-bodied. Almost 43 meters long, it has 18 sails for a total of 1,000 sq meters of sailcloth. The sailboat belongs to a non-profit association, Jubilee Sailing Trust, who takes people aboard to experience tall-ship sailing. ## Le Barthélemy Hotel & Spa In The Running For Mipim Awards



Every year, MIPIM (International Real Estate Professionals) meets in Cannes, where awards are presented for the most beautiful architectural projects around the world. In the “best hotel and tourist complex” category, a hotel in St Barth has been nominated: Le Barthélemy Hotel & Spa, in its new version designed by Philippe Stouvenot, will perhaps be the winner at the awards ceremony on March 14. France has the most nominations among the 21 countries in the running for these awards in all categories.

## The Press Praises Saint Barth And Its Luxury Hotels

After the article, “St Barth Is Back,” in The Times in the UK, and an article in the New York Post in the US, Le Figaro has just published its take on our island, with an “exclusive” visit to the Cheval Blanc Isle de France, the luxury hotel on Flamands beach, which has been partially open since December. “The legendary hotel in Flamands, on one of the most beautiful beaches on the island, has started a new chapter in its history, as created by three designers of international renown,” writes journalist Claudine Hesse. As of today, 41 rooms and suites in the five-star hotel owned by LVMH are open. The former Taiwana hotel, purchased by the same group, will follow in several months. Another article, on the specialized website Maison.com, is about the renovation of the bohemian-chic hotel, Manapany, in Anse des Cayes.

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# Alain LeChatelier: Tropical Fever At Les Artisans

**H**is technique is exquisite. His colors are delicious. His sense of humor tantalizing, his love for the tropics keeps growing... French painter Alain Le Chatelier ([www.alainlechatelier.com/](http://www.alainlechatelier.com/)) has fallen head over heels in love with the Caribbean. As of this year, he will not only spend a few months in St Barth, but he and his husband, architect Roland Pichon, are now officially residents of Guadeloupe, where they have just built a house in Deshaies and will spend their winters. "It's more tropical," says the artist. "St Barth is very dry compared to Guadeloupe, which is humid and lush in terms of vegetation."

This vegetation can be seen in a lot of Le Chatelier's paintings, where envelopes of greenery embrace rivers, and sunlight dances on the running water, while butterflies and dragonflies flutter fetchingly. He is also attracted to the dryer landscapes of Saint Barth as he juxtaposes cacti, a prickly subject indeed, with the turquoise waters of the sea and sailboats bobbing on the horizon.

His new paintings will



certainly attract attention and are worth examining closely, as this is familiar territory for the artist. Take a close look at an explosion of colors in a bouquet of flowers, compelling shades of orange, pink, and red, bold colors as if from India... but Le Chatelier's sense of humor (or is it artistic perversity) can be seen in the objects that surround the flowers: "Things that are totally different," he says. "Objects that are useful, some for eating or pulling out corks, pliers, forks, all opposed to the flowers, which are an object of beauty or symbol of feminine sexuality."

Another painting has a

softer collection of flowers, pastel pinks, blues, and white, with a lamp shedding light on the scene, where we know it's 2pm by the clock on the kitchen wall. The artist's signature black shoes with red laces are in one corner, while garlic, a wine carafe, a wasp, a butterfly, and lots of utensils complete the image, as if someone brought an armful of beautiful blooms into a busy kitchen.

An owl beer stein filled with romantic roses, a small lizard nearby to add a Caribbean note, tropical fruit in a footed bowl with cactus and a sailboat in the background, overlooking

Loirent where a tiny corner of *Autour du Rocher* peeks into the scene. Visit a terrace in *Flamands* where a mango tree, small blue pool, a visiting iguana, ochre walls, and a fluttering dragonfly await you. Or delight in lilacs and Japanese cherry blossoms with teaspoons dancing in the light.

The artist also invites you into the living room of his country house in Berrule, where one painting is a juxtaposition of opposites: "Hard green and hard red," he points out. "Like Vasarely, the colors are bold, almost kinetic, your eyes detect movement." Other paintings channel the spirit of 16th-century Italian painter, Arcimboldo; they must be seen to be believed.

From topical gardens to a rather sexy mermaid—an aqueous beauty reclining on a large clamshell, fish in her hair, and feathery undersea flowers—the details in all of Le Chatelier's paintings are extraordinary, the brushwork perfection.

Donning fins, masks, and snorkels, the kids were not afraid to jump in the water even though the weather was overcast. As part of the Educational Marine Zone program, two CM1 classes from the elementary school in Gustavia went on their first observational visit to the site near Les Petits Saints, small islands off the shore of St Barth, a zone monitored under the aegis of the Territorial Environmental Agency (ATE). Accompanied by Cécile Berton of the ATE, representatives from Serial Divers, their teacher, and several parents, the students discovered the beautiful underwater milieu around Les Petits Saints. In transparent waters they saw sponges, coral, angelfish, sergeant

major fish, trumpet-fish, sea urchins... And other fish curious about what was going on. In groups wearing fins, the kids looked and listened, concentrating in the waves, as the specialists offered explanations. "I loved it, I want to go back," said one happy little girl as she got back into the boat.
