



Cultural Diversity

he Christmas Village is one of the highpoints of the holiday season. The main dock in Gustavia comes alive with various merchants selling lots of nice gifts, and special events are programmed from concerts to a photo op with Santa Claus. But it's really a lot more than that: for one thing it highlights the cultural diversity of the island. The island's Jewish community celebrates Chanukah —the Festival of Lights —on the dock one of the eight nights of the holiday, with the lighting of the Menorah, and Chanukah latkes and doughnuts served along with music and dancing. In addition, the Portuguese Folklore Group shows off its music, dancing and traditional costumes. And other musical traditions include Creole Christmas carols. among others. The market also provides a place for locals to stroll along the dock in the evening, meet friends, and catch up on the latest news.

For a tiny island like Saint Barth, the cultural diversity makes for some interesting juxtapositions. Once the weekly pre-Carnival parades start in January, people can't help but hear the beat of the tambours, as groups such as La Pointe en Mouvement and the Younz parade thru Gustavia with drums made from goat skins in the traditional manner. Steel drums evoke the rhythms of Trinidad, and local bands play Jamacia-influenced reggae and zouk from Guade-loupe, for example.

Another highpoint of the holiday season is the Christmas truck that drives from village to village with a band playing and caroling their way across the island. Including an obligatory stop for about 30 minutes in front of Le Select, with people happily dancing in the streets. A local tradition one hopes will continue for many years to come.

DENGUE ON THE RISE

Workers are calling in sick and services are running at a snail's pace as dengue fever has continued to rise in Saint Barthélemy for the past several weeks. In fact, according to the latest bulletin from Santé Publique France, the number of clinically evocative cases seen in consultations now exceeds one hundred (over 200 in Saint Martin). At the same time, the number of emergency room visits has more than doubled in one week, from 25 to 54. The number of hospitalized patients is also on the rise, with 11 cases reported, compared to just seven cases a week earlier. In Saint Barthélemy, almost 400 clinical cases have been diagnosed since the start of the epidemic. For the time being, the Northern Isles remain in phase

3 of the epidemic, while Guadeloupe and Martinique have moved to stage 4.

Recommendations remain the same. Preventing dengue fever is everyone's concern. Every citizen must ensure that all potential breeding grounds (any water receptacle where mosquito larvae can develop) be eliminated in the vicinity all homes. Use insect repellents and wear long clothing. For the record, dengue fever is a virus that can only be transmitted from mosquitoes to humans. The incubation period is between five and ten days. Symptoms include fever, fatigue, aches and pains, and sometimes nausea. In the event of high fever, consult a doctor.

DONATION OF A CARDIAC DOPPLER ULTRASOUND MACHINE AT THE HOSPITAL

The Hospital de Bruvn now boasts a new piece of equipment: a Cardiac Doppler Ultrasound Machine. This machine observes the heart, blood vessels, and blood flow via moving ultrasound images. The echodoppler, which cost 65.000 euros, was donated to the hospital by a generous donor, Bruno Joverot. An investor in various establishments on

SPORTS COMPLEX RENOVATIONS IN SAINT JEAN




On Friday, November 24, the Collectivité's Sports Service organized a short ceremony to announce the renovation of the four courts at the Saint Barth Tennis Club and the basketball courts at the sports complex Saint Jean.

The renovations, which began at the end of August, on the four tennis courts (surfacing and fencing) had been included in the 2023 annual budget of 398,000 euros in investments. Renovation work was completed in mid-November. "The project was organized in such a way as to ensure that the club's members could continue to play on two courts while the work was being carried out", explains the Collectivité, adding that the process used is the same as that employed for the courts at the US Open, the Grand Slam tournament held every year at Flushing Meadows (New York, USA). For the basketball court, the island used the same company, Azur Tennis, for the renovations the court, which cost an additional sum of 42,900 euros. The work was carried out during the first three weeks of November.

Alexis Wozniak To Swim Around The Island

Alexis Wozniak, age 32, is taking on the challenge of swimming around the island of Saint Barthélemy. Weather conditions permitting, he will set off this Saturday, December 9 at 7am from the surf shack in Lorient for an eight- to nine-hour effort.

he gamble seems a little crazv. But if it weren't, it wouldn't be much of a challenge. At least, not for Alexis Wozniak. The 32-year-old, who has lived and worked in Saint Barthélemy for six years, will attempt to swim around the island. A feat he reckons he can achieve in less than nine hours. If all goes as he hopes, "without a hitch." Alexis Wozniak will set off on Saturday, December 9, at 7am in front of the surf shack on the beach in Lorient. The challenge is to swim approximately 26 kilometers without fins or hand paddles, wearing only a swimsuit, swimming cap, and goggles.

"With Willpower, Anything Is Possible"

"I want to get out of my comfort zone," says the young man. "I believe that if you want to evolve in any field, you have to do it. I want to show that with willpower, determination and desire, anything is possible. As long as you're convinced of this and you put in place the means to achieve it, then there's no reason for you to fail. And if you must fail, then you learn so that you can try again, but above all not give up or give in."

One question remains unanswered, however: how could a water polo enthusiast, a fan of short, concerted efforts in calm water, have the desire to take on a long-distance open-water swim?



"I know, it's the last straw, especially for me, who's never liked long distances, and even less so in open water," he confesses. But my desires have changed and, as I keep saying, I wanted to get out of my comfort zone."

Support During The Crossing

It goes without saying that Alexis won't be alone during the eight, nine, or ten hours of swimming that await him on Saturday. He will be followed throughout his crossing by a safety boat. On board, people who will be monitoring his progress (with first-aid equipment loaned by the NIS company) will also help him to refuel using a pole. "Because I can't touch the boat, hang on to it, let alone climb on it," Alexis stresses. He will also be able to count on some of his Saint-Barth



Triathlon comrades, who will be spending part of the crossing alongside him. Their support is just as vital as that of Arno Apremont, who will be gliding along on his paddle not far from the swimmer. A presence that should enable him, during the inevitable moments of physical or psychological failure, to hold on to his final goal. "Mentally, I'm ready. As I often say, as long as the light doesn't go out, you can move forward."

Rendezvous set for Saturday morning, 7am, Lorient beach: Alexis Wozniak will set off from the surf shack and embark on a counter-clockwise tour of the island. With, hopefully, enough support to make it all the way around.
